

# Setting Up Your iPad

## *Your Apple ID?*

*According to Apple: "An Apple ID is your user name for everything you do with Apple: Shop the iTunes Store, enable iCloud on all your devices, buy from the Apple Online Store, make a reservation at an Apple Retail Store, access the Apple Support website, and more."*

*Apple's terms and conditions state that users must be 13 years of age or older to have a personal Apple ID. This means that prior to 13 years of age, the Apple ID associated with a child's iPad is the parents'/guardians' AppleID for that device, and not the student's. Consequently, we ask parents/guardians of children under the age of 13 to create and manage their child's Apple ID. Parents can decide whether to continue to manage their child's Apple ID once he/she turns 13 years of age.*

***With this in mind, we'd like you to use the Student's School email address as this Apple ID. We want to be best able to provide technical support to our students. In order to do this we need to be able to access the emails sent to them whilst they are at the school. When you use your private email address this becomes very difficult. For example, there are times when a student forgets their password associated with their Apple ID. Apple sends the reminder to the email address registered with the Apple ID. For this reason, if the student uses their school email address we are able to provide them with the immediate support and can get the problem resolved quickly.***

***Although the student could use a family or parent's Apple ID, we strongly discourage it. The reason for this is that we have seen problems occur when this has been done. Apps and Books, etc, may appear on all devices, credit card information can be utilised by all and iCloud details are shared (which causes problems when one person deletes another's work). iMessages meant for adults are received by the children and vice-versa. We recommend that each user has their own account, and that in the Student's case, this account includes NO Credit Card details.***

*Additionally, the email address that is used for an Apple ID can always be changed (providing it is not an iCloud address) by visiting [Apple's Manage My Apple ID](#) page. So if you have already created an Apple ID and want to change it to your school email address, it can be easily done at [this link](#).*

# Setting Up Your iPad

The steps we will use to Setup the iPad are;  
Basic out-of-the-box setup.

Setup email to receive the Apple ID verification.

Download a Free App as part of the Apple ID setup.

Open the iPad box and you will find the iPad and it's USB charger.

(Remember to charge the iPad when it gets below approx 10%.)

Turn on the iPad using the button on it's top-right-corner.



Select British English from the Welcome screen.



Select Australia as the Region.



Enable Location Services.



Join your WiFi Network. (We will add the school's WiFi code )



Choose Setup as a New iPad.



Choose Skip this Step with the Apple ID.



Confirm the skip.



Agree to the Terms and Conditions.




